FRUIT VARIETY RECOMMENDATIONS

Apples	Ginger Gold---Gala---Honeycrisp---Golden Supreme---Golden Delicious---Fuji- Arkansas Black
Peaches	PF-1---Blazingstar---Challenger--Contender---China Pearl (white)---Encore
Apricots	Goldcot---Harglow---Both are self-fertile. Harglow is late blooming.
Sweet Cherry	WhiteGold---Stella---BlackGold---Lapins. All are self-fertile BlackGold is late blooming.
Tart Cherry(Pie)	Balaton---Danube. Self-fertile and late blooming. Larger and sweeter than Montmorency. Good for fresh market also.
Plum	Earliblue---Castleton---Stanley. European type, self-fertile, late blooming.
Thornless blackberry	Triple Crown---Chester (semi-upright)---Apache--- Navajo (upright)
Raspberry	Polana---Autumn Britten---Caroline. All are everbearers (fall).
Strawberry	Honeoye---Jewel(spring bearers)---Everest---Tribute---Seascape (everbearers).
Table Grapes	Himrod (white)---Reliance (red)---Mars (blue-black). All are seedless.
